OFFICE OF THE CONTROLLER NO.3 DOMESTIC TRAVEL MEASURES

- I, Commissioner David Manning, Controller, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 9 of the *National Pandemic Act 2020* and all other enabling powers, hereby issue the following measures:
- 1. No roadblocks are to be established by any person, including authorised officers, except for those Directed by the Controller.
- No person(s) may travel by aircraft from one province in PNG to another province in PNG, unless provided an exemption in writing by the Controller or his delegate.
- 3. Paragraph 2 does not apply to flight crew who are flying a flight approved by the controller per paragraph 4.
- 4. Subject to paragraph 5, no domestic flight(s) may occur from one province in PNG to another province in PNG, unless provided an exemption in writing by the Controller or his delegate.
- 5. The following flights are exempted from paragraph 4:
 - a. cargo flights with no passengers; and
 - b. medivac flights.
- 6. All flight(s) that occur under paragraph 5, shall within 24 hours of occurring submit to the Office of the Controller the following:
 - a. flight manifest; and
 - b. cargo manifest.
- 7. All domestic flights must comply with the following requirements:
 - a. hygiene and social distancing restriction as issued by the Controller; and



- b. all passengers must complete an Air Passenger Travel Form which are to be submitted to Provincial Health Authority on arrival.
- 8. Travel by foot, vehicle and vessel between Provinces, unless otherwise restricted by the Controller by written Direction, shall not be restricted.
- A person or organisation that allows a person to board an aircraft in breach of paragraph 2
 and 4 shall be deemed to have committed an offence under the *National Pandemic Act*2020.
- 10. A person or organisation that does not comply with paragraph 6 and 7 shall be deemed to have committed an offence under the *National Pandemic Act 2020*.
- 11. A person or organization that does not comply with the directions of an Authorised Officer in accordance with preceding paragraphs shall be deemed to have committed an offence under the National Pandemic Act 2020.
- 12. Any Authorised Officer(s) appointed by the Controller pursuant to the Act, shall carry out and enforce these Measures accordingly.
- 13. These Measures come into effect on 07 August 2020 and shall apply until the end of the Declaration of a Pandemic under the Act, or as varied or revoked by the Controller.

Schedule 1 - Valid Reason for Domestic Travel

- Students returning to their usual place of residence or returning to their educational institution (one way tickets to be issued);
- Persons returning to their usual residence (one way tickets will be issued);
- Essential services;
- Essential business travel;
- · Seeking medical assistance and medivac; and
- Emergency transport, including but not limited to repatriation of deceased persons.
