	[Background and current situation] Since 2012, the school enrollment rate in PNG has been improving due to the government's policy of free education, but the number of children per classroom has increased sharply as the number of students enrolled has increased, so quality of education is still a big issue. In addition, the Government is trying to shift the policy from the conventional performance-based education to the standard-achieving education, and there is an urgent need for efforts such as formulating a curriculum, developing teaching materials, teacher training, and revising assessments in line with the new policy. In addition, there is an extreme shortage of technical personnel who will lead the industry in relation to the problem of basic education.
